Resolution 270

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING CHARGES FOR NEW METERS AND WHOLESALE RATES AND A PROCEDURE FOR CREDITNG CUSTOMERS AFTER LEAK REPAIRS AND RESCINDING RESOLUTION NUMBER 265

WHEREAS, the costs of all aspects of water district operations have substantially increased since the District established it's present meter charges and wholesale rates, and

WHEREAS, a rate increase is necessary to maintain the present level of service, repair and maintenance of the system, and

WHEREAS, all customers of the District shall be charged for services on a fair and equitable basis, and

WHEREAS, the District feels it fair to authorize a <u>ONE TIME ONLY</u> adjustment to water consumed during a leak:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Water Commissioners of Water District No. 83, King County, Washington, as follows:

- 1. That effective with the signing of this Resolution, new meter installation charges shall be adjusted as outlined on Exhibit A.
- 2. That the wholesale rate for water service be revised as follows:
 - a). For adjustments to current customers charges for water consumed during a water leak: Water used in addition to a historical average to be charged at 80 percent of the current retail rate. This is to be a one time only adjustment.
 - b). For water sold to other entities, the rate will be established at the time of the contract.
- 3. That Resolution number 265 be and is hereby rescinded.
