

RESOLUTION NO. 302

ESTABLISHING RATES FOR WATER SERVICE
AND RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 299

WHEREAS, the costs of all aspects of water district operation has undergone change since the Water District established its present rates; and

WHEREAS, a rate adjustment is necessary to maintain the present level of service, repair and maintain the system, build reserves to provide needed capital improvements to the systems, and provide the necessary funds to repay Public Works Trust Fund loans; and

WHEREAS, all customers of the District shall be charged for services on a fair and equitable basis;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Water Commissioners of Lake Forest Park Water District, King County, Washington, as follows:

1. That effective with the signing of this Resolution, for all water consumed as of January 1, 2005, all customers of the District shall be charged for water service in accordance with the following rates:

5/8 X 3/4" meter – one premise:	\$ 18.50 per month
All water consumed	\$ 2.20 per 100 cubic feet

1" meter – one premise:	\$ 31.20 per month
All water consumed	\$ 2.20 per 100 cubic feet

1-1/2" meter – one premise:	\$ 62.39 per month
All water consumed	\$ 2.20 per 100 cubic feet

2" meter – one premise:	\$101.50 per month
All water consumed	\$ 2.20 per 100 cubic feet

3" meter – one premise:	\$202.97 per month
All water consumed	\$ 2.20 per 100 cubic feet

4 "meter – one premise:	\$312.16 per month
All water consumed	\$ 2.20 per 100 cubic feet

6" meter – one premise:	\$624.31 per month
All water consumed	\$ 2.20 per 100 cubic feet

8" meter – one premise:	\$998.86 per month
All water consumed	\$ 2.20 per 100 cubic feet

Each additional residence served on the same tax parcel same meter:	\$ 10.90

2. Demand and growth charges levied by the City of Seattle for service to the Lake Forest Park Towne Centre shall be assessed against the Towne Centre.
3. That Resolution No. 299 be hereby rescinded.
